Please bring the following to Drive Up/Drop Off and Meet your Teacher:

- Completed Student Registration Form (provided in this packet, please feel free to write on the back as needed)
- 2. Completed Permission and Release Form (provided in this packet)
- 3. First month's tuition cash or check (made payable to Growing Minds Preschool)
- 4. Non-Refundable Co-Vid Fee of \$30 per student cash or check (can be included on tuition check)
- 5. School Supplies except items listed to be brought on the first day of school
- 6. Copy of child's birth certificate even if child has attended GMP in the past
- 7. Copy of child's immunization records -even if child has attended GMP in the past
- 8. 2 family pictures for your child's teacher to keep and use in the classroom. These can be pictures of anything or anyone important to your child.

2 year olds

- 1 pack of 8 count washable Crayola Markers

3-6 year olds

- 2 large tubs of disinfecting wipes
- 1 pump container of gel hand sanitizer (minimum 60% alcohol 8 oz or larger)
- 1 can of Lysol spray
- 2 tubs of Baby Wipes
- 1 roll paper towels
- 1 box tissue
- 1 4 pack of Play-Doh
- 4 packs of 24 count Crayola Crayons
- 12 glue sticks must be Elmer's Washable Disappearing Purple
- 2 dry erase markers used by kids and they love the fun colors
- 1 plastic pencil box labeled with child's name
- 1 pair of Fiskars 5 inch classic blunt-tip scissors (place inside pencil box)

School Supplies to be brought on the first day of class - All Students ages 2-6

- Regular sized backpack with your child's first name clearly labeled on the outside (a regular sized folder must fit inside when zipped)
- 1 pocket folder with child's first and last name written on outside of folder in black marker
- One water bottle with flip top lid labeled with child's first and last name -this will be taken home daily to be washed
- One Zip-Loc bag with a complete change of clothes (underwear, socks, shirt and bottoms) for your child in case of an accident. Child's first and last name must be written on the ziploc bag. This will stay in their backpack and come home each day.
- Completed Parent Questionnaire (you will receive this form at DriveUp/Drop Off)

What should my child wear to school?

- We ask that all children wear tennis shoes to school everyday. We climb, jump, run
 and play each day at preschool and tennis shoes work best in our active environment.
 We ask that tennis shoes fit well and will stay on your child's feet when running.
 (Non-tying shoes preferred)
- Children should wear clothes which they can easily manage on their own in the restroom. Please avoid belts, difficult buttons, one piece rompers, or anything that is difficult to manage while sitting on a toilet.
- We get messy at preschool. Children may get paint, play-doh, markers on their clothes while at school.

Dropping off and pick up procedures

All of these procedures are being implemented in order to keep our students, staff and families as safe as possible.

In the past, parents have brought their child into the building and to their classroom. However, in following CDC guidelines, parents will not be allowed in the building. Please be patient with us as we implement these new procedures - it will take several days to make the process run smoothly. We also ask that everyone remains flexible as these procedures may change if necessary.

It is very important that your child use the restroom before being dropped off at school.

Drop Off

- Arrive at your child's assigned door promptly at the start time of their class.
- Teacher and/or assistant will come outside and take your child's temperature. If your child's temperature is 100.4 or higher, they will not be allowed to come to school.
- All children will then enter the building and be taken directly to wash their hands.
- Please be prompt for daily drop off.
- If you arrive late, please go to Door C and call the phone number posted. A teacher will come to the door to take your child's temperature, wash hands and escort them to class.

Pick Up

- Children will be brought, with their backpacks, to their assigned door at the end time of their class.
- All parents should line up socially distanced at the assigned door.
- Teacher will ask for your child's code word (you submitted this at online registration)
- Children will be released one at a time to their caregiver.
- Please be prompt for daily pick up.

Before Care Drop Off Procedures

Growing Minds offers before care Monday-Friday beginning at 7:15am. You may drop off your child anytime between 7:15-8:15am. The cost is \$5 per day and you do not need to register for this in advance.

- Arrive at Door D with your child. Teacher at before care will meet you at the door. Please sign your child in at the desk and pay \$5.
- Teacher will take your child's temperature and children's hands will be sanitized upon entering the building. All children will wash hands before going to their classroom.

Late Pick Up Fine Policy:

Excluding emergencies, if a parent is late picking up a child at the end of the school day a fine of \$5 for the first 10 minutes and \$1.00 per minute after will be assessed. Should you find yourself in an emergency, please call/text your child's teacher immediately. If your child will be absent, please send a text to your child's teacher cell phone number.

In the event of bad weather, we follow the Silver Creek School Corporation for weather closures.

- If SCSC is closed, Growing Minds Preschool is closed as well.
- If SCSC is on a two hour delay, Growing Minds morning classes will begin 1 hour after the normal schedule. Afternoon classes will begin on time.
- In the event of a covid closing at SC schools, we will evaluate if a closing at Growing Minds is necessary and communicate as promptly as possible.

Tuition Information

- Tuition is due on the first of each month and will be considered late if not paid by the 10th of the month. A \$25 late fee will be assessed after the 10th of the month.
- Tuition may be paid in cash, check, on our website (with a processing fee) or by signing up for ACH withdrawal from a checking account.
- The first tuition payment is due at your scheduled drive up/drop off night. (This is considered the September Tuition payment)
- Each child paying by cash or check on a monthly basis will receive a tuition envelope sent home each month in your child's folder. Please put the tuition inside the tuition envelope and inside your child's folder when paying.
- If paying by check, please make the check payable to Growing Minds Preschool and write your child's name in the memo section.
- There will be a \$25 returned check fee for any bounced check.
- Tuition is paid in 9 EQUAL monthly payments regardless of days in school for that month.
- Due to the rise in all costs of business this year, there will be no discount given for paying in full for the 2020-2021 school year.
- Tuition is non-refundable and is due regardless of sick days or vacations.

COVID Tuition Plan

In the event that we would have to close the building and go to e-learning, tuition would drop to 50% of the normal tuition rate starting the first of the next month. Online zoom meetings/lessons along with packets will be provided for students in the event of elearning.

For example: Due to COVID we would have to close the building on November 17th. Starting in December we will charge 50% of the normal tuition. Tuition will not be prorated or refunded for a month that has already been paid.

COVID Fee

For the 2020-2021 school year, each student will be asked to pay one time non-refundable COVID fee of \$30. When budgeting and setting tuition for the school year, no one had heard of COVID. We have purchased many new items that will help us maintain the highest level of safety for our families at Growing Minds Preschool. Some of the safety items have already been purchased and some items we may not know we even need yet. Items purchased:

- Air Sanitizing Machines
- Thermometers for each classroom
- Face Shields and Masks for Staff
- Hand Sanitizer stations
- Non-toxic chemical supplies to clean toys in a quick/safe manner
- Foggers and Sprayers to dispense chemicals in play areas both indoor and outdoor We are also working on a plan to have electrostatic cleaning done on a regular basis from an outside company.

Recap of New Policies

- Masks are not required for students but are welcome to wear them if desired.
- Face coverings will be worn by the teachers.
- Temperatures will be taken at the door and logged and a child with a temperature of 100.4 or above will not be allowed to enter the building.
- No parents or visitors may come into the building for any reason, even to use the restroom.
- All children will be taken to wash hands immediately upon entering the building.
- All snacks and birthday treats must be store bought. (2 year olds do not bring snacks and birthday treats)
- No tuition discount will be given for paying in full.
- A non-refundable \$30 Co-Vid fee per child will be due at Drive Up/ Drop Off meet your teacher night.
- If Growing Minds would have to switch to e-learning, tuition would drop to 50% of the normal monthly rate.

Snacks

Growing Minds teachers will assign each child to a certain number of snack days throughout the year. On this day your child will be responsible for providing healthy **STORE BOUGHT** snacks for the entire class. Snacks must still be sealed in the original packaging when brought to school.
